1. Joshua has 358 marbles. Ray has 117 marbles less than Joshua. How many marbles does Ray have?
2. Amanda has 325 stamps. She has 112 stamps more than Irene. How many stamps do both girls have in all?
3. Bill has 65 marbles more than George. If George has 137 marbles, how many marbles does Bill have?
4. Mr Tan divides her class into 8 groups. If there are 5 pupils in each group, how many pupils are there in her class?
5. A basket contains 2 red apples and 3 green ones. How many apples are there in 6 such baskets?
6. Mrs Goh bought 7 boxes of mooncakes. There were 4 mooncakes in each box.
 - (a) How many mooncakes were there in the 7 boxes?
 - (b) Mrs Goh gave 3 mooncakes to each of her 4 children. How many mooncakes did she have left?
7. Lisa went on a holiday trip with her 2 sons and 3 daughters. Each of them brought 2 pairs of shoes. How many pairs of shoes did they bring altogether?
